



MMFL FOOTBALL PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET

The MMFL is a proud member of The Big South Youth Football & Cheerleading League (BSYF). The MMFL consist of two teams. These teams are made up and operated by a Commissioner and volunteers. All the teams in the BSYF are located in the surrounding counties. The teams in the BSYF travel to area Middle and High School football stadiums to play their games. The league is made up of two levels of playing skills, Division 1 and Division 2. Each Division is made up of four age groups:

Tiny Mite (ages six (6) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any player in the Tiny Mites age group shall not attain the age of 7 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in this age level who exceeds 65 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Mighty Mite (ages eight (8) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any player in the Mighty Mites age group shall not attain the age of 9 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in this age level who exceeds 90 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Junior Varsity (ages ten (10) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any player in the Junior Varsity age group shall not attain the age of 11 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in this age group who exceeds 120 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Varsity (ages twelve (12) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any player in the Varsity age group shall not attain the age of 13 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Division 2: A player in Division 2 who exceeds 135 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play and CANNOT play middle school football (**no dual participation**).

Division 1: A player in Division 1 who exceeds 160 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play and CAN play both BSYF and middle school football (**dual participation**)

PARENTS:

- The MMFL does not require you to work in the stadium at your child's game. However, your child's team may ask for parent volunteer for team specific events and fundraisers.
- Registration fee for football is \$110 and is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. This fee will be required at the time of registration. Make checks payable to MMFL.
- You will also be required to purchase the game uniform (\$90), practice pants, mouth guard, chin strap and cleats.
- MMFL will supply a certified helmet, shoulder pads and practice jersey.
- ALL football players wishing to participate in the MMFL program must register during the regular registration period which ends July 31st.
- ALL football players and parents must sign and adhere to the MMFL Discipline Policy and the Uniform agreement.
- Your child's team may ask you to sign and adhere to their individual team policies.
- The MMFL does not supply transportation to or from any practice or game. Arrangements of transportation to and from these activities are the responsibility of the parent or guardian.
- Football players are expected to attend all practices and games. Multiple unexcused absences will be handled at the discretion of each coach.
- Practice schedules are determined by the coaching staff and will be held at local fields in Mooresville. Parents are responsible for confirming practice field and times. Games are played on Saturday.
- ALL football players must provide their **original birth certificate** and **proof of address** at the time of the weigh-ins in August. (Certification)
- All football players are required to have a physical examination **PRIOR TO ANY PARTICIPATION** in the MMFL program. This includes practices.

MMFL Football and Cheerleading Discipline Policy

All members will adhere to the following team rules. It is the understanding of the player/cheerleader/parent/coach that most situations will follow the offense policy that follows. However, it is up to the discretion of the coach and/or league director to review a situation that does not fit neatly into the original rules. Team rules and infraction policies are as follows:

Any of the following actions by any youth participant will result in suspension from a football game(s) and/or practice(s).

- A. Fighting**
- B. Malicious foul**
- C. Throwing or destroying any league uniform or equipment**
- D. Substance abuse**
- E. Insubordination**

Fighting will automatically suspend a youth from the following week's game. Any youth using profanity during a game will be warned by any coach or commissioner on the first offense, and ejected from the game on the second offense. Any youth found carrying, participating, or under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances will be immediately suspended from any further participation in the league. No tobacco products of any kind are to be allowed on the playing field.

Any youth ejected from a game for any reason must appear on the sideline with his/her coach at the following week's game. It is the responsibility of the team coaches to see that the practice sessions are conducted with the same rules of conducts that govern a game.

If any parent of guardian violates the rules of the organization their child will be suspended indefinitely.

- 1. ATTENDANCE TO PRACTICES IS MANDATORY. If you miss a practice and your coach was not notified before practice began, it will be at the coach's discretion to take disciplinary action(s).**
- 2. TARDINESS FOR GAMES AND PRACTICES IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. Players and cheerleaders are expected to arrive on time for games, practices, and other functions. It is suggested that you plan to arrive five (5) minutes prior to each practice, and one (1) hour prior to each game (depending on each coach's specific rules).**
