The MMFL is a proud member of The Big South Youth Football & Cheerleading League. There are many teams in MMFL. We have Division 1 teams and Division 2 teams which are made up of four age groups:

Tiny Mite Division 1 & Division 2:

(Players ages six (6) and under) A player in the Tiny Mites Division shall not attain the age of 7 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in the Tiny Mites Division who exceeds 65 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Mighty Mite Division 1 & Division 2:

(Players ages eight (8) and under) A player in the Mighty Mites Division shall not attain the age of 9 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. If a player is age 7 the current playing year, they may play in this division. A player in the Mighty Mites Division who exceeds 90 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Junior Varsity Division 1 & Division 2:

(Players ages ten (10) and under) A player in the Junior Varsity division shall not attain the age of 11 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in the Junior Varsity Division who exceeds 120 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play.

Varsity Division 1 & Division 2:

(Players ages twelve (12) and under) A player in the Varsity Division shall not attain the age of 13 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. A player in the Division 2 Varsity Division who exceeds 135 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play and CANNOT play middle school football (no dual participation). A player in the Division 1 who exceeds 160 pounds cannot advance the ball on any offensive play and CAN play both Big south League and middle school football (dual participation).

PARENTS:

- **PARENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WORK IN THE STADIUM AT YOUR CHILDS GAME. WATCH YOUR CHILD PLAY AND ENJOY YOUR DAY! :)**
- Parents are required to purchase: Game Uniform (\$90), Practice Pants, Mouth Piece, Chin Strap, and Cleats.
- MMFL will supply all other necessary equipment for football players.
- ALL football players wishing to participate in the MMFL program must register during the regular registration period.
- ALL football players and parents must sign and adhere to the MMFL Discipline Policy and the Uniform Agreement.
- The league will not supply transportation to or from any practices or games. Transportation to and from these activities is the responsibility of the parent or guardian.
- Football players will be expected to attend all practices and games. Multiple unexcused absences will be handled at the discretion of each coach. A football player may be asked to sit out of a game if necessary.
- Practice schedules are determined by the Coach(s) and will be held at local school fields. Parent(s) are responsible for confirming practice field and time. Games are played on Saturday.
- ALL football players will be responsible for a NON-REFUNDABLE \$110.00 sign-up fee that will be due at the time of registration. Each player will receive 5 discount cards to sell for \$10 each, for a partial reimbursement of the registration fee.
- Make \$110.00 check payable to MMFL.
- ALL NEW football players must provide their original birth certificate at the time of the weigh-ins in August.
- All football players are required to have a physical examination **PRIOR TO ANY PARTICIPATION** in the MMFL program. This includes practices.

Thank you for your interest in the Mooresville Midget Football League Cheerleading Program. The MMFL is made up and run by a Commissioner and volunteers. The document contains general information. Changes may be made at a later date. Our program consists of four cheerleading squads for our football teams.

Tiny Mite Division: (Players ages six (6) and under) Cheerleader in this division shall not attain the age of 7 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Mighty Mite Division: (Players ages eight (8) and under) Cheerleader in this division shall not attain the age of 9 prior to August 1st of the current playing year. If a participant is age 7 the current playing year, they may cheer in this division.

Junior Varsity Division: (Players ages ten (10) and under) Cheerleaders in this division shall not attain the age of 11 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Varsity Division: (Players ages twelve (12) and under) Cheerleaders in this division shall not attain the age of 13 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

PARENTS:

- **PARENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WORK IN THE STADIUM AT YOUR CHILDS GAME. WATCH YOUR CHILD PLAY AND ENJOY YOUR DAY! :)**
- ALL cheerleaders wishing to participate in the MMFL program must register during the regular registration period.
- ALL cheerleaders and parents must sign and adhere to the MMFL Discipline Policy.
- The league will not supply transportation to or from any practices or games. Transportation to and from these activities is the responsibility of each parent or guardian.
- Cheerleaders will be expected to attend all practices and games. Practice schedules are up to each coach, and games are played on Saturdays. Multiple unexcused absences will be handled at the discretion of the coach.
- ALL cheerleaders will be responsible for a NON-REFUNDABLE \$60.00 sign-up fee that will be due at the time of registration.
- Make \$60 checks payable to MMFL.
- ALL NEW cheerleaders must provide their original birth certificate.

MMFL Football and Cheerleading Discipline Policy

All members will adhere to the following team rules. It is the understanding of the player/cheerleader/parent/coach that most situations will follow the offense policy that follows. However, it is up to the discretion of the coach and/or league director to review a situation that does not fit neatly into the original rules. Team rules and infraction policies are as follows:
Any of the following actions by any youth participant will result in suspension from a football game(s) and/or practice(s).

- A. Fighting**
- B. Malicious foul**
- C. Throwing or destroying any league uniform or equipment**
- D. Substance abuse**
- E. Insubordination**

Fighting will automatically suspend a youth from the following week's game. Any youth using profanity during a game will be warned by any coach or commissioner on the first offense, and ejected from the game on the second offense. Any youth found carrying, participating, or under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances will be immediately suspended from any further participation in the league. No tobacco products of any kind are to be allowed on the playing field.

Any youth ejected from a game for any reason must appear on the sideline with his/her coach at the following week's game. It is the responsibility of the team coaches to see that the practice sessions are conducted with the same rules of conducts that govern a game.

If any parent of guardian violates the rules of the organization their child will be suspended indefinitely.

- 1. ATTENDANCE TO PRACTICES IS MANDATORY.** If you miss a practice and your coach was not notified before practice began, it will be at the coach's discretion to take disciplinary action(s).
- 2. TARDINESS FOR GAMES AND PRACTICES IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Players and cheerleaders are expected to arrive on time for games, practices, and other functions. It is suggested that you plan to arrive five (5) minutes prior to each practice, and one (1) hour prior to each game (depending on each coach's specific rules).
